Join the Tampa Audubon Society as we search for owls through the park's natural areas. As you check in at the Rangers Station, they will direct you to a pavilion where we will all meet for a brief session before our walk. We will spend 20 - 30 minutes learning about owls then we will go for a walk where we will look and listen for owls.

This event will take place outdoors after sunset so you will need to dress appropriately for outdoor weather conditions. We also recommend that you bring water. We will be walking on trails in the park at night so it's important to wear appropriate shoes and bring bug spray.

The Owl Prowl is free. There is a \$5.00 admission fee to enter the State Park. Come early and enjoy the park before the event. In addition to owls, there are lots of birds in the park including many warblers, woodpeckers and raptors this time of year.
